The Philadelphia Sailing Club will sponsor an all-day course featuring instruction of skills needed for sailors of all levels. The classes will be focused on those skills most helpful in sailing on yachts 25-45 feet. You do NOT need to be a PSC member to participate but must be 21 or older, or 15 or older accompanied by someone 21 or older.

Upon registration, you will be given access to several on-line videos covering sailing terms and basic knots. On Friday, March 31, from 7:00-8:30PM an instructor will review this material or answer any questions.

Saturday will start with beginners and advanced sailors working together on procedures for leaving and returning to the berth or dock, including docking strategies, line handling and knots. After 11:45 registrants may choose between two different class modules at each step: (1) Sailing Theory or Advanced Sail Trim, (2) Tacking & Gybing or Docking, (3) Rules of the Road or Anchoring, (4) Chart Reading or Passagemaking Tips, (5) Navigating with Electronics or Heavy Weather Sailing. With lots of choice there will be content for sailors at all levels.

The classes will be taught by experienced skippers who can also share their insights about cases that class attendees may wish to discuss. Instruction will be supported by graphics, videos and hands-on experiences.

The **cost for the whole day of classes is ONLY \$27** because this event is being underwritten by the Philadelphia Sailing Club and supported by volunteers from its membership.

These classes will **be held at the Tredyffrin Library, Strafford, PA from 9:00AM to 5:00M.** Check-in and coffee and donuts beginning at 9:30. Attendees should bring their own food for breaks and lunch

Class size will be limited to about 30 people in order to ensure quality of interaction. In the past these classes have sold out early so register soon! Registration will only be effective upon receipt of a **registration form** and a check **made out to Philadelphia Sailing Club mailed to: Ralph Harris, Box 264, Worcester, PA 19490-0264,** or given to Ralph Harris at the next PSC General Meeting (February 15 or March 15).
